

Ethics and Discipline findings

Following are Ethics and Discipline Committee findings for **Dr. Ryan P. Doyle**:

2009-Sep-16:

Discipline Finding - Under section 37.1 of the Health Professions Act, Dr. Ryan Doyle admitted to publishing advertising materials (1) that were misleading and indicated he could “obtain results not achievable by other members”, contrary to the former Rules Pursuant to the Chiropractors Act, (2) that used the title “doctor” without any indication that the health care practitioner concerned was a chiropractor contrary to what was then permitted under the Chiropractors Act*, and (3) in breach of a prior undertaking requiring him to obtain College approval before publishing any advertising. Based on those admissions, Dr. Doyle consented to an order from the Inquiry Committee reprimanding him, and requiring that he enter into a new undertaking to have his advertising approved prior to publication for two years, and pay a fine of \$4,000 and costs of \$2,650.

* Under the Health Professions Act and the Chiropractors Regulation, chiropractors are permitted to use the titles “chiropractor” and “doctor” but are no longer required to use them in combination (section 12.1 of the Act and section 2 of the Regulation).
