

Following are Discipline Findings for **Dr. Murray S. Kievit**:

Discipline Finding - Under Section 37.1 of the Health Professions Act, Dr. Murray Kievit admitted that (1) he failed to properly advise a patient and obtain her consent prior to placing his hands in the front of her pants and examining and treating in the area of the pubic bone, and (2) his use of a teddy bear during treatment was without clinical benefit, inappropriate to any intended clinical purpose, and demonstrated a lack of gender sensitivity. Based on those admissions, Dr. Kievit consented to an order from the Inquiry Committee (1) reprimanding him, (2) suspending him for three months, and requiring that he (3) have a chaperone present for a two year period for all assessment, examination or treatment of female patients involving sexually sensitive areas, (4) attend a course on gender sensitivity, boundary issues and communication, (5) prepare an apology letter to the complainant, and (6) pay costs of \$4,904.77.
