Publication of discipline:

Following investigation by the Inquiry Committee under section 33(4) of the *Health Professions Act* of allegations arising out of a government audit of his practice, Dr. John Ly admitted to (1) submitting claims to MSP and receiving payment for patient care for which he did not have clinical records; and (2) submitting claims to MSP and receiving payment for patient care that he did not render. Based on these admissions, Dr. Ly consented under section 36 of the *Health Profession Act* to the following terms for resolution: (1) a reprimand; (2) a 90-day suspension, 30 days of which will be held in abeyance if he complies with the other terms for resolution; (3) a fine of \$10,000; (4) costs of \$5,250; (5) completion at his own expense of a course on record keeping and a course on professional ethics; and (6) upon a request from the Registrar made within the next six months, opening his office to an audit by the College, at his own expense.
